Summary of Job:

A special projects operator will be an instrumental member of the DLC Resources team. This position will be responsible for safely operating a variety of specialized equipment including backhoes, skid steers, Gannon's, and skip loaders to complete landscape construction projects. Skilled Operators must demonstrate or complete training and skills tests that include field testing for safe operation of specialized equipment. When not assigned to equipment operation, Special Projects Operators will be assigned to complete other landscape and construction functions.

- Complete assigned construction related projects through the safe operation of equipment
- Perform landscape construction functions such as clearing trenches, digging holes, and general work site clean-up
- Responsible for maintaining a clean, safe work environment and ensuring the proper care of tools and equipment
- Prune and trim trees, shrubs, and flowers, lawn moving and other landscape duties as assigned
- Responsible for general clean-up and trash removal
- Regular use of power and hand tools to complete projects
- Operate power riding mowers, chainsaws, pole saws, blowers, weed eaters, chippers, gas hedge trimmers other equipment and vehicles in completing projects or landscape tasks
- Operating equipment around work site
